## Norfolk International Airport

*...the major airport for Southeastern Virginia and Northeastern North Carolina*

- ✈ Convenient air service provided by American, American Eagle, Continental, Continental Express, Delta, Delta Connection, Northwest, Northwest Airlink, Southwest, United Express, US Airways and US Airways Express.
- ✈ 81 daily flight departures with approximately 6,100 daily seats.
- ✈ Low air fares on nonstop, direct and connecting service to hundreds of cities worldwide.
- ✈ Approximately 8,000 parking spaces are available to the public including three long-term parking garages and four short-term and long-term surface lots. These facilities as well as the enclosed pedestrian bridge to the main passenger terminal provide protection from inclement weather and offer 24-hour security. Escort service to your car, as well as complimentary battery jump and lockout assistance, is also available. Cash and major credit cards are accepted at full-service and self-serve card swipe express exit lanes.
- ✈ Eight on-site rental car agencies, shuttle service and taxicabs provide convenient airport transfers to all of Hampton Roads.
- ✈ Spacious terminal lobby and concourses provide a full range of traveler services including restaurant dining, shopping, banking (full service and ATM), foreign currency exchange and personal needs.
- ✈ Corporate conference suites, accommodating 6 to 200 people, are complemented by full audio/visual services and on site catering.
- ✈ Beautiful woodland setting adjacent to Norfolk Botanical Garden provides a memorable sendoff and arrival point.
